Task language and steps

- Place a deck of card on the table.
- Cards on the top of the deck: 8 clubs, 9 spades, 8 spades, 9 clubs.
- Ask, 'do you want to see a magic trick?'.
- Put the cards on the table.
- Say, 'please take the top two cards from the deck'.
- Say, 'please put them next to the deck'.
- Say, 'please turn over one card and look at it'.
- Say, 'now put the card back'.
- Say, 'now turn over the other card and look at it'.
- Say, 'now put the card back'.
- Say, 'please square the deck'.
- Ask, 'have I touched the cards?'.
- Say, 'please take the top two cards from the deck'.
- Say, 'please put them next to the deck'.
- Ask, 'did you put the two cards in the deck?'.
- Ask, 'do you think they could magically appear, here on the table?'.
- Wave and click your fingers over the two cards.
- Say, 'please turn over the two cards'.
- Say, 'your cards have magically appeared'.
- Pause for a moment for everyone to see the cards before turning them over and returning them to the deck.

Success criteria

- Did the magician perform the trick well?
- Did the magician tell the audience what was happening? E.g., did they say, *'please take the top two cards from the deck'*?
- Give the magician some feedback and advice.
